What I really like about volunteering there....

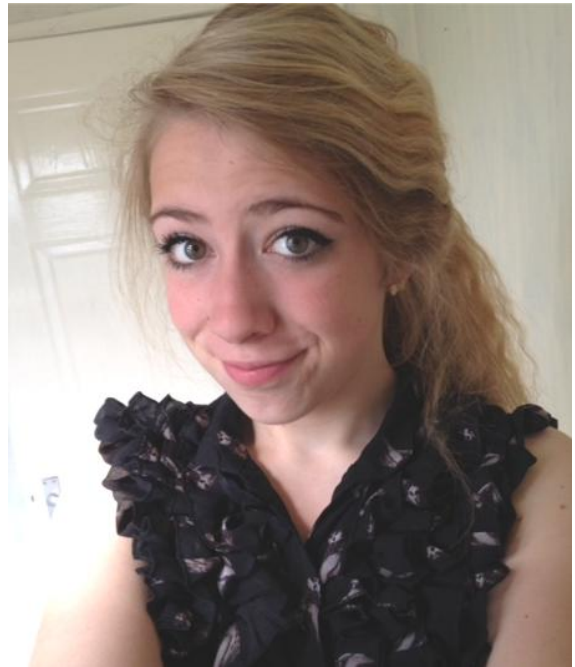
